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Business description

Clerhp Estructuras (CLR), is a small structural engineering company (vertically integrated). In 2022, it acquired land in the Dominican Republic (DR) to start the Larimar project (construction of c.20,000 apartments and villas, hotels...). Completely changing the company. It would become (from 2025e) essentially a tourism and residential developer in DR. CLR has been listed on BME Growth since March 2016.

6m25 results: Uncertainty about financing is key and increases risk.

REVENUE FALLS 27.9%. 1H 2025 revenue stood at EUR 6.2Mn, -27.9% vs. 1H24. This change is explained by the evolution of the Euro/Dollar exchange rate, which had a 12.8% impact, the temporary halt of construction work due to the migratory crisis involving Haitian citizens, which caused a drastic reduction in the available labor force, and delays in the start of certain projects by some clients.

RECURRING EBITDA FALLS 51.6%. The gross margin and EBITDA reflect the impact of accounting for the change in inventories of EUR 14.3Mn. Among other items, this figure includes the capitalization of certain expenses (personnel, general, and financial) amounting to EUR 1.96Mn. Therefore, due to the above and the low level of activity, we conclude that these results do not offer relevant evidence of the company's operating performance.

CLR HAS OBTAINED US\$15MN IN FINANCING FROM A PANAMA BANK, BUT IT IS INSUFFICIENT TO COVER FINANCING NEEDS. Although it is a step in the right direction, the amount is insufficient to cover the financing needs required for the construction of the homes to be delivered in 2026, which were initially set at EUR 44Mn. In addition to the above financing, CLR has signed an agreement for the structuring of a bond program of up to US\$75Mn on the Panama Latinex stock exchange. However, the placement is not guaranteed, and therefore its success is uncertain at this point. Finally, the MARF commercial paper program amounts to EUR 50Mn, with the current outstanding balance being EUR 2.9Mn.

CAPITAL INCREASE OF APPROX. EUR 9.0MN IN JULY. On July 28, 2025, CLR formalized a capital increase by debt-to-equity swap (set-off of credits) amounting to EUR 7.7Mn, corresponding to short-term liabilities registered at the parent company as of June 30, 2025. Also on July 28, the Board of Directors agreed to a second capital increase at the parent company amounting to EUR 1.3Mn, through the conversion of bonds issued in 2021 by Inveready. The joint impact of both increases reduces the group's short-term liabilities by EUR 9.0Mn.

FINANCIAL FORECASTS HAVE BEEN WITHDRAWN, SUGGESTING A SIGNIFICANT INCREASE IN BUSINESS RISK. CLR announced, concurrently with the publication of results, that the Board of Directors had decided to withdraw the financial forecasts it had previously published, and it has not updated them nor provided a date for a future update. The uncertainty generated by this decision negatively impacts the risk premium in relation to the uncertainty in obtaining the necessary financing required for the execution of the project, which is the key to the investment case. As of 6M2025, the company had an equity of EUR 7.7Mn, which, combined with the July capital increase, leaves the equity at EUR 16.7Mn. This, in relation to the LCR project (approx. EUR 310Mn in investment according to our numbers), implies a theoretical risk (financial and accounting) regarding the capacity to respond to unforeseen events (crises affecting demand, impairments). Financing could theoretically be obtained with an increase in Net Debt and the financing of working capital with suppliers, although given the magnitude required, it seems inevitable that a portion will be secured through an equity increase, with significant potential for dilution of the current shareholding.
