


Business Description

Atrys Health SA is a Spain based biomedical company which focuses on developing tools for the diagnosis and treatment of cancer and precancerous conditions. It offers diagnostic services in the fields of pathology, hematology, molecular pathology, and genetics. The company uses telemedicine to provide its services in the medical specialties of radiology, cardiology, ophthalmology, and dermatology.

Valuation ^Qas of 1 May 2024

Morningstar affirms a 3-star quantitative rating for Atrys Health. We calculate this outcome using the company's underlying model-driven valuation and uncertainty scores.

The stock's last closing price was 2.82, a discount of 37.12% to its Quantitative Fair Value estimate of 4.48. This discount has ranged between 49.05% and 19.34% over the past year. The stock's price to fair value ratio is at the 30th percentile in our global equity coverage universe for this methodology and at the 49th percentile relative to its peers in the healthcare sector.

Atrys Health furthermore holds a Very High quantitative uncertainty rating.

The company's quantitative star rating dates to after 09/15/2023, before which it was 4-star. Similarly, the firm's uncertainty rating changed from Extreme to Very High after 04/01/2024.

We examine the financials and market statistics for Atrys Health to determine these ratings. Its enterprise value-to-market value ratio is 2.02 and its sales yield is 92.51%. These fall at the 87th and 64th percentiles in the equity universe and at the 91st and 80th in the healthcare sector, respectively. With a Morningstar quantitative moat rating of None, the quantitative moat score for Atrys Health falls at the 34th percentile in the healthcare sector and at the 30th in the equity coverage universe. The company has maintained its None quantitative moat rating for the last year.

We also assign a Moderate quantitative financial health rating to Atrys Health. The company's raw score on this metric, termed Distance to Default, ranks at the 43rd percentile overall and 42nd in the healthcare sector. Furthermore, this financial health rating has stayed Moderate over the last year.

Supporting these ratings are the company's book value yield and enterprise value-to-market value ratio. The book value yield of 135.37%, ranks at the 82nd percentile in the covered equity universe and at the 88th percentile among its peers. Meanwhile, its enterprise value-to-market value ratio of 2.02, falls at the 87th percentile in the universe and the 91st percentile in the healthcare sector.

Fundamentals as of 1 May 2024

Atrys Health maintains losses per share of -0.6. The company further earns a return on invested capital of -2.79%. These values are calculated over a trailing 12-month period.



i. **Quantitative Fair Value Estimate:** Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

Narrow – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

Wide – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

None – assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars.

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10% Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15% but greater than 10%

High – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

 $Very\ High\ -$ the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

 $\ensuremath{\textit{Extreme}}\xspace -$ the interquartile range for possible fair values is greater than 80%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

Weak – assigned when Quantitative Financial Health < 0.2

Strong - assigned when Quantitative Financial Health > 0.7

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i. Last Close – Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.

ii. **Quantitative Valuation**– Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's **Last Price** and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

Undervalued – Last Price is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

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
