


#### **Business Description**

Secuoya Grupo De Comunicacion Sa operates a video production facility. It is engaged in the creation, production and distribution of audiovisual and digital content. The company also offers support and business process outsourcing.

### Valuation as of 2 May 2024

Morningstar maintains a 3-star quantitative star rating for Secuoya Grupo De, derived from the firm's valuation and uncertainty scores.

The company's shares last closed at 5.55, in-line with our quantitative fair value estimate of 5.46. These shares have traded between a 19.04% discount and 14.73% premium to their fair value estimate over the past year. In Morningstar's equity coverage universe for this methodology, the company's valuation rating lands at the 92nd percentile; in the communication services sector, the firm's score lies at the 95th percentile (meaning the shares are more undervalued than 95% of stocks in the sector).

Furthermore, Secuoya Grupo De maintains a quantitative valuation uncertainty rating of Very High.

The company has held this star rating over the past year. The uncertainty rating for Secuoya Grupo De has remained Very High since the previous rating of Extreme, which was last assigned on 02/14/2024

The key factor behind these ratings is the company's earnings yield of 1.68% which falls above the 50th percentile in the communication services sector. Over the past year, the company's earnings yield has been between 1.68% and 1.68%.

### Economic Moat as of 2 May 2024

Quantitatively, we believe Secuoya Grupo De has a Narrow economic moat. Its moat score of 0.9 corresponds to the 83rd percentile in the communica-

tion services sector. Furthermore, this rating has not changed over the past year, while the company's moat score is near its maximum in this period

The company also maintains a quantitative financial health rating of Moderate. Its score sits at the 73rd percentile overall and the 72nd percentile in the sector.

Examining the company's financials and market statistics, we find these ratings are principally driven by its book value yield and enterprise value-to-market value ratio. The book value yield is 2.99%, sitting at the 10th percentile in the communication services sector. The company's enterprise value-to-market value ratio is 1.51, corresponding to the 78th percentile in the equity coverage universe and the 74th percentile in the sector.

## Fundamentals as of 2 May 2024

Secuoya Grupo De maintains earnings per share of 0.63. The company further earns a return on invested capital of 11.65%. These values are calculated over a trailing 12-month period.


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

# **Quantitative Equity Report Overview**

The quantitative report on equities consists of data, statistics and quantitative equity ratings on equity securities. Morningstar, Inc.'s quantitative equity ratings are forward looking and are generated by a statistical model that is based on Morningstar Inc.'s analyst-driven equity ratings and quantitative statistics. Given the nature of the quantitative report and the quantitative ratings, there is no one analyst in which a given report is attributed to; however, Mr. Lee Davidson, Head of Quantitative Research for Morningstar, Inc., is responsible for overseeing the methodology that supports the quantitative equity ratings used in this report. As an employee of Morningstar, Inc., Mr. Davidson is guided by Morningstar, Inc.'s Code of Ethics and Personal Securities Trading Policy in carrying out his responsibilities.

## **Quantitative Equity Ratings**

Morningstar's quantitative equity ratings consist of: (i) Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, (ii) Quantitative Star Rating, (iii) Quantitative Uncertainty, (iv) Quantitative Economic Moat, and (v) Quantitative Financial Health (collectively the "Quantitative Ratings).

The Quantitative Ratings are calculated daily and derived from the analyst-driven ratings of a company's peers as determined by statistical algorithms. Morningstar, Inc. ("Morningstar", "we", "our") calculates Quantitative Ratings for companies whether or not it already provides analyst ratings and qualitative coverage. In some cases, the Quantitative Ratings may differ from the analyst ratings because a company's analyst-driven ratings can significantly differ from other companies in its peer group.

- i. Quantitative Fair Value Estimate: Intended to represent Morningstar's estimate of the per share dollar amount that a company's equity is worth today. Morningstar calculates the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate using a statistical model derived from the Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies. Please go to http://global.morningstar.com/equitydisclosures for information about Fair Value Estimate Morningstar's equity analysts assign to companies.
- ii. **Quantitative Economic Moat:** Intended to describe the strength of a firm's competitive position. It is calculated using an algorithm designed to predict the Economic Moat rating a Morningstar analyst would assign to the stock. The rating is expressed as Narrow, Wide, or None.

**Narrow** – assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 70% but less than 99%.

**Wide** — assigned when the probability of a stock receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is greater than 99%.

**None** — assigned when the probability of an analyst receiving a "Wide Moat" rating by an analyst is less than 70%.

- iii. **Quantitative Star Rating:** Intended to be the summary rating based on the combination of our Quantitative Fair Value Estimate, current market price, Quantitative Uncertainty Rating, and momentum. The rating is expressed as One-Star, Two-Star, Three-Star, Four-Star, and Five-Star.

After the initial calculation for the star rating, there is a final filtering step based on the momentum of the company. We rank the companies based on their 12-1 month momentum, then restrict those below the 30th percentile to a maximum of 3 stars

iv. **Quantitative Uncertainty:** Intended to represent Morningstar's level of uncertainty about the accuracy of the Quantitative Fair Value Estimate. Generally, the lower the Quantitative Uncertainty, the narrower the potential range of outcomes for that particular company. The rating is expressed as Low, Medium, High, Very High, and Extreme.

Low – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 10%
Medium – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 15%
but greater than 10%

 $\overrightarrow{\text{High}}-\text{the}$  interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 35% but greater than 15%

**Very High** – the interquartile range for possible fair values is less than 80% but greater than 35%

v. **Quantitative Financial Health:** Intended to reflect the probability that a firm will face financial distress in the near future. The calculation uses a predictive model designed to anticipate when a company may default on its financial obligations. The rating is expressed as Weak, Moderate, and Strong.

### Other Definitions

- i. Last Close Price of the stock as of the close of the market of the last trading day before date of the report.
- Quantitative Valuation— Using the below terms, intended to denote the relationship between the security's Last Price and Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate for that security.

**Undervalued – Last Price** is below Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Farily Valued – Last Price is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

**Farily Valued – Last Price** is in line with Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate.

Overvalued – Last Price is above Morningstar's quantitative fair value estimate

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Based on their quantitative scores, companies are grouped into one of five Risk Categories (negligible, low, medium, high, severe). These risk categories are absolute, meaning that a 'high risk' assessment reflects a comparable degree



of unmanaged ESG risk across all subindustries covered.

The ESG Risk Rating Assessment is a visual representation of Sustainalytics ESG Risk Categories on a 1 to 5 scale.
