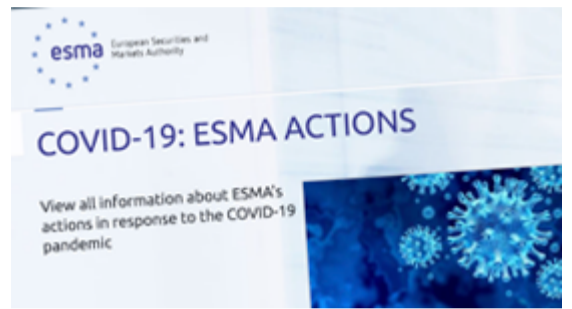
Extension of the period for submitting annual periodic information

The MAB, due to the economic and social impact of COVID-19, agrees to extend the period for submitting the issuing entities' annual periodic information. To this end, the issuing entities must submit the Company's periodic information to the Market as soon as possible and in any case no later than six months after the close of the fiscal year. Furthermore, the MAB recommends a responsible use of this extension, putting always transparency before investors ahead. [MORE +](#)



MAB figures: 1st quarter 2020

Figures achieved in this 1st quarter, conditioned by the COVID-19, are less negative compared to other exchanges from surrounding countries. The **Ibex MAB 15** and **Ibex MAB All Share** indices have declined by 13% and 12% respectively. 119.8 million of securities traded with a cash volume of €234.5 million. 2 new companies have been incorporated, **MAKING SCIENCE** and **HOME CAPITAL RENTALS** and more than €136 million have been raised through 14 corporate transactions.



ESMA recommends action by MAB companies for COVID-19 impact

The European Securities and Markets Authority (ESMA) recommends action by European financial market participants, including MAB companies, for COVID-19 impact. For example, the issuers should disclose as soon as possible any relevant significant information concerning the impacts of COVID-19 on their fundamentals, prospects or financial situation. Gamma Communications ends its takeover bid for VOZTELECOM

The terms of the offer have been accepted by 94.90% of VOZTELECOM shareholders once the acceptance period has ended. Therefore, as the condition precedent is fulfilled, the offer is accepted and executed at a price of €4.42 per share, which represents an increase of 52% compared to the initial price of the security at MAB (€2.90).
